### I. Progress Report re Fire Incident in Davao City (Region XI)

#### A. Situation Overview

On 16 August 2019, 11:21 AM, a fire incident transpired at Brgy. 23, Davao City. Based on the initial result of the investigation, the cause of fire is electrical overload. Fire was declared out at 4:04 PM, 16 August 2019.

#### B. Effects

#### Affected Population

 A total of <u>500 families/2,460 individuals</u> were affected and is currently staying in <u>Zonta Elementary School and Brgy Covered Court</u>

#### **Damaged Houses**

A total of 150 houses were totally damaged due to the incident.

#### Cost of Damages

An <u>estimated cost of damage worth ₱2,625,000.00</u> was incurred.

#### C. Actions Taken

#### OCD XI

Conducted coordination with CDRRMO for situation updates.

#### DSWD XI

 Closely coordinating with Davao City Social Service and Development Office (CSSDO) for other social services assistance to affected families.

#### **CDRRMC Davao**

Closely monitoring the area.

 Fire suppression was conducted by Davao Central 911, Davao City Central Fire Station, Bucana, BDRRMC Matina Crossing, BDRRMC Maa, BDRRMC Brgy. 19-B, Filipino Chinese Firefighters Foundation, Task Force Davao, and Knightwalk Rescue.

#### **CSSDO** Davao

Provided hot meals to affected families.
