I. Initial Report re: Fire Incident at Brgy. San Isidro, Cainta, Rizal

A. Situation Overview

On August 19 at around 9:10 AM, a fire incident occurred at V.V. Soliven Avenue, Bagong Sibol, Brgy. San Isidro, Cainta, Rizal. The fire was declared under control at 10:45 AM. No casualties reported.

B. Effects

Affected Population

- A total of **246 families or 875 individuals** were affected.

C. Actions Taken

OCD IV-A

- Continuously coordinating with DSWD IV-A, BFP IV-A, Rizal PDRRMO and Cainta MDRRMO on the status of the evacuees and other concerns regarding the incident.

BFP

- Conducting further investigation on the incident.

II. Initial Report re: Fire Incident at Kolambog, Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City

A. Situation Overview

On August 20 at around 3:44 PM, a fire incident transpired at Kolambog in Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City. Cause of fire is still under investigation.

B. Effects

Affected Population

- A total of **11 families or 73 individuals** were affected. **One (1)** individual was reported dead.
