I. Flooding Incident in Paoay and Batac, Ilocos Norte (REGION I)

A. Situation Overview

On 31 August 2019, the water level of Quiaoit River in Batac City started to rise and later overflowed due to the continuous moderate to heavy rains experienced over the province of Ilocos Norte. A breached earth dike in Batac City also contributed to the flow of water in the nearby barangays and also affected the barangays in the low-lying areas of the Municipality of Paoay. The affected residents have evacuated to safe areas. As of 01 September 2019, they have already returned to their houses.

B. Effects

1. Affected Population

A total of 3,291 families / 11,337 persons were affected in 49 barangays in Batac City, Curimao, and Paoay, Ilocos Norte. Of which, a total of 10 families / 27 persons were served inside 1 evacuation center in Batac City.
