I. Flooding Incident in Paoay and Batac, Ilocos Norte (REGION I)

A. Situation Overview

On 31 August 2019, the water level of Quiaoit River in Batac City started to rise and later overflowed due to the continuous moderate to heavy rains experienced over the province of Ilocos Norte. A breached earth dike in Batac City also contributed to the flow of water in the nearby barangays and also affected the barangays in the low-lying areas of the Municipality of Paoay. The affected residents have evacuated to safe areas. **As of 01 September 2019, they have already returned to their houses.**

B. Effects

1. Affected Population

A total of **3,291 families / 11,337 persons** were affected in **49 barangays** in Batac City, Curimao, and Paoay, Ilocos Norte. Of which, a total of **10 families / 27 persons** were served inside **1 evacuation center** in Batac City.

C.Actions Taken

RDRRMC I

Office of Civil Defense I

- Coordinated with Naval Forces Northern Luzon (NFNL) for possible augmentation of rescue teams and DSWD FO I for validation of affected population.
- Continuous monitoring of the area of responsibility (AOR).

Department of Social Welfare and Development FO I

- Coordinated with the Social Welfare and Development (SWAD) Team Leaders, the P/M/C Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils, and P/M/C Social Welfare and Development Offices.

PDRRMC Ilocos Norte

- Deployed resources from PNP Maritime, Philippine Army, and Philippine Air Force to Paoay for augmentation in the possible evacuation of residents.

- Continuously monitoring the situation.

CDRRMC Batac

- Conducted initial assessment on the affected areas and possible evacuation in some Barangays.
- Assisted stranded motorists in the area.

MDRRMC Paoay

- Ongoing assessment of the affected areas.

D. Cost of Assistance

A total of **₱146,180.00** worth of assistance was provided by LGUs to affected families in the City of Batac, Ilocos Norte.
