The Tropical Depression outside PAR has slightly intensified and is now moving in an east-northeastward direction.

The LPA developed into a Tropical Depression at 8:00 PM on 08 September. It is expected to enter PAR today and will be named "MARILYN". The trough of the Tropical Depression and the Southwest Monsoon will bring scattered light to moderate rains with at times heavy rains (during thunderstorms) over Mindoro Provinces, Romblon, Marinduque, northern portion of Palawan (including Calamian and Cuyo Island), Visayas and Bicol Region. This weather disturbance is less likely to make landfall in the country.

The public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council concerned are advised to monitor for the next update on this weather disturbance to be incorporated in the Public Weather Forecast at 4 PM today and 4 AM. The next advisory at 11 AM tomorrow.
