**The Tropical Depression outside PAR has slightly intensified and is now moving in an east-northeastward direction.**

<b>Location of Center (10:00 AM today)</b>	The center of Tropical Depression was estimated based on all available data at <b>1,495 km</b> East of Visayas (OUTSIDE PAR) ( <b>13.1°N, 139.3°E</b> )
<b>Maximum Sustained Winds</b>	<b>55 km/h</b> near the center
<b>Gustiness</b>	Up to <b>70 km/h</b>
<b>Movement</b>	<b>East Northeast at 15 km/h</b>

<b>Saturday evening</b> 14 September 2019	<b>965 km</b> East of <b>Basco, Batanes</b> ( <b>21.2°N, 131.2°E</b> ) Tropical <b>Storm</b>
<b>Sunday evening</b> 15 September 2019	<b>1,225 km</b> East Northeast of Basco, Batanes ( <b>24.6°N, 133.0°E</b> ) <b>Severe Tropical Storm</b>
<b>Monday evening</b> 16 September 2019	<b>1,460 km</b> East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (Basco, Batanes) (OUTSIDE PAR) ( <b>26.8°N, 134.5°E</b> ) <b>Severe Tropical Storm</b>

The LPA developed into a Tropical Depression at 8:00 PM on 08 September. It is expected to enter PAR today and will be named "**MARILYN**". The trough of the Tropical Depression **and the Southwest Monsoon** will bring scattered **light to moderate rains with at times heavy rains (during thunderstorms) over Mindoro Provinces, Romblon, Marinduque, northern portion of Palawan (including Calamian and Cuyo Island), Visayas and Bicol Region**. This weather disturbance is less likely to make landfall in the country.

The public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council concerned are advised to monitor for the next update on this weather disturbance to be incorporated in the Public Weather Forecast at **4 PM today and 4 AM. The next advisory at 11 AM tomorrow.**
