#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

The **Low-Pressure Area (LPA)** outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) has developed into a **Tropical Depression**.

<b>Location of Center (1:00 AM today)</b>	The center of Tropical Depression was estimated based on all available data at <b>1,355 km East of Visayas (OUTSIDE PAR)(12.3°N,137.1°E)</b>
<b>Maximum Sustained Winds</b>	<b>45 km/h</b> near the center
<b>Gustiness</b>	Up to <b>55 km/h</b>
<b>Movement</b>	<b>Almost stationary</b>

#### **Forecast Positions and Intensities**

<b>Tomorrow evening</b> 12 September 2019	960 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (14.2°N, 133.1°E) Tropical Depression
<b>Friday evening</b> 13 September 2019	1,000 km East of Baler, Aurora (15.8°N, 130.9°E) Tropical Depression
<b>Saturday evening</b> 14 September 2019	860 km East of Calayan, Cagayan (18.6°N, 129.6°E) Tropical Depression
<b>Sunday evening</b> 15 September 2019	920 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (22.8°N, 130.5°E) Tropical Depression
<b>Monday evening</b> 16 September 2019	1,185 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (Basco, Batanes) (OUTSIDE PAR) (25.2°N, 132.3°E) Tropical Depression

- The **LPA** developed into a Tropical Depression at 8:00 PM on 08 September. It is expected to enter PAR today and will be named "**MARILYN**".
- The trough of the Tropical Depression will bring scattered rain showers over Eastern Visayas and Bicol Region.
- This weather disturbance is less likely to make landfall in the country.

- The public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council concerned are advised to monitor for the next update on this weather disturbance to be incorporated in the Public Weather Forecast at 4 AM today and in the next advisory at 11 AM today.

## II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Tropical Cyclone Advisory No. 1** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
