I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The **Low-Pressure Area (LPA)** outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) has developed into a **Tropical Depression**.

Location of Center (1:00 AM today)	The center of Tropical Depression was estimated based on all available data at 1,355 km East of Visayas (OUTSIDE PAR)(12.3°N,137.1°E)
Maximum Sustained	45 km/h near the center
Winds	8
Gustiness	Up to 55 km/h
Movement	Almost stationary

- The **LPA** developed into a Tropical Depression at 8:00 PM on 08 September. It is expected to enter PAR today and will be named "**MARILYN**".
- The trough of the Tropical Depression will bring scattered rain showers over Eastern Visayas and Bicol Region.
- This weather disturbance is less likely to make landfall in the country.
