**I. Progress report regarding capsized pump boats in the vicinity waters of Guimaras and Iloilo (Region VI)**

**A. Situation Overview:**

- On 03 August 2019, at around 2:00 PM, two (2) pump boats plying between Iloilo and Guimaras capsized due to bad weather.
- At around 3:30 PM, same day, another pump boat capsized while routing Buenavista, Guimaras to Iloilo.

**B. Effects:**

A total of 96 persons were affected, of which, 31 were reported dead, as follows:

## C. Actions Taken:

### RDRRMC VI

- In close coordination with PDRRMO Guimaras, CDRRMO Iloilo (ICER) and PCG Western Visayas for updates of the incident.
- Coordinated with member of local IMT and response cluster of CDRRMC Iloilo at the Joint Incident Command Post set up by Iloilo City and Guimaras.
- Coordinated with concerned agencies re response efforts.
- Conducted an Emergency Meeting with OCD VI Regional Director, PNP Region VI Regional Director, DSWD, DILG, PCG, Iloilo City Mayor, and PDRRMO Guimaras held at the Conference Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor PRO 6, Camp Martin Delgado, Fort San Pedro, Iloilo City;
- Facilitated the request for C-130 thru NDRRMC to transport the retrieved bodies/ victims of pump boats to Batangas, Cebu and Mindanao areas.
- Facilitated the transfer of two (2) cadavers to their place of origin via C-130.



- Establishment of Regional Incident Management Team (IMT) in Parola Wharf, Iloilo City to ensure effective and efficient response operations.
- Attended Response Cluster Meeting at Joint Iloilo City-Guimaras Incident Command Post on 08 August 2019.

#### **DSWD VI**

- Provision of non-food items to the stranded persons as follows:
  - 38pcs blankets
  - 38 packs clothing
  - 38 pcs banig
  - 38 pcs towels
  - 38 pcs malongs
- Provided Mental Health and Psychosocial support to the survivors.
- Provided medical and financial assistance to the survivors and their families.
- DSWD-FO VDSWD-FO VI augmented to Department of Health (DOH) to conduct Mental Health Psychosocial Support Services (MHPSS) to the victims at 6 locations in Iloilo.
- DSWD-FO VI is continuously coordinating with the concerned Local Government Unit of Iloilo City for any relevant updates and possible additional augmentation/assistance needed.
- DSWD-FO VI is conducting needs assessment of pump boat crew for possible provision of livelihood assistance for those who will be eligible of DSWD Sustainable Livelihood Program (SLP).
- DSWD-FO VI assessed victims for financial assistance to cover other urgent needs aside from food.
- DSWD-FO VI is continuously coordinating with concerned LGU for any relevant updates and additional augmentation/assistance needed.
- Conducted Mental Health and Psychosocial Support to Survivors and families of dead casualties.
- Provided assistance to sea crews, stranded and affected by the suspension of Motorized banca trips to and from Guimaras.

#### **DILG VI**

- Activated MDM Cluster with PNP, NBI DSWD PRC and LGUs Guimaras and Iloilo City with the following activities;
  - Presence of NBI and PNP Crime Lab for MDM Dead-Victim identification (DVI).
  - Coordinated with Dumangas MDRRMO and PNP.
  - Coordinated and conducted DVI to the following hospitals, to wit: Western Visayas Medical Center (WVMC), Iloilo Mission Hospital (IMH), St. Paul's Hospital, Ramon Duremdes District Hospital (Dumangas, Iloilo), and at Barangay McLaine, Buenavista, Guimaras.
- Distributed twenty (20) cadaver bags from RedCross to be used for the retrieval of the bodies found in Dumangas Port;
- Deployed DILG Personnel: DRR-FPs and alternate, MLGOOs, PD, and Cluster Head of the concerned Provincial and City Offices: Iloilo Province, Iloilo City, and Guimaras.



- Coordinated with the LCEs and reactivated the Joint Iloilo-Guimaras OPCEN for the monitoring of data of the dead, missing and survivors of MB Chi-Chi, MB Jenny Vince, and Keziah.

#### **DOH VI**

- Provided the following Non-Food Items:
  - 25 cadaver bags
  - 20 jerry cans
  - 3 Hygiene kits
- Deployed Human Resource persons at Joint Iloilo-Guimaras ICP.
- Provided MHPSS at Mission Hospital and Porras Funeral Homes for the victims and bereaved families.
- Established assistance desk at Parola Port.
- Provided psychosocial support to the survivors and the families of the casualties.
- Activated Operation Center and coordinated with PHO Guimaras re logistical support.

#### **TOG VI – 505 Search and Rescue**

- Deployed one (1) chopper to conduct aerial operations for search, rescue and retrieval along Iloilo-Guimaras Strait and Dumangas waters.
- Provided mobility to the stranded passengers.
- Prepositioned one (1) humanitarian assistance team.
- Transported two (2) cadavers to Malabon and Bataan with their families and relatives from Iloilo International Airport to Villamor Airbase via C130.
- Provided gas allocation for the ambulance used to transport recovered cadaver.

#### **301<sup>st</sup> Brigade AFP**

- Prepositioned two (2) Humanitarian Assistance Disaster Response Team.
- Established 301<sup>st</sup> Brigade Operations Center for easy coordination with the UMT of Iloilo City and Guimaras.

#### **Maritime Police**

- On-going retrieval operations of remaining missing passengers by the RMU 6 and 601st MARPSTA personnel.
- Transported the stranded passengers to RORO Lapuz through with PRO VI dump truck.
- Provided police security assistance at Lapuz Port.

#### **Philippine Navy**

- Conducted Search, Rescue and Retrieval Operations along the shorelines of Negros Occidental and Iloilo.
- Deployed a bigger vessel (PC 372) on 8 August 2019 at 8:00 AM to continue the SAR Operations



- Transported RDRRMC members to Guimaras via BRP Alfredo Peckson as well as strandeers from Guimaras port to Iloilo City on 7-8 August 2019.

#### **PCG Western Visayas**

- Rescue operations is ongoing as of 2:00 PM, August 3, 2019.
- Survivors were immediately brought to the nearest hospitals for medication.
- All boat trips between Iloilo and Guimaras has been cancelled to ensure the safety of passengers.
- Ongoing search and rescue operations for the remaining passengers.
- Facilitated the travel of the stranded passengers to Guimaras through an arrangement with the management of FF Cruz Shipping Line.

#### **PCG Iloilo**

- Provided assistance through the arrangement of the additional RORO trips plying Iloilo to Guimaras in coordination with Montenegro Shipping Lines Inc (MV Marie Teresa), Tri-Star Megalink Corp (LCT Our Lady of the Philippine Navistar 2).

#### **PNP**

- Validation of data of the passengers

#### **PRC and Unicorn Rescue Group.**

- Facilitated transfer of rescued passengers to the identified evacuation center and provided assistance.

#### **PRC Iloilo**

- Provision of hot meals for the strandeers.
- Provided two (2) teams of ambulance unit at the PAROLA and Lapuz RORO Wharf to assist in the medical needs of the stranded passengers.

#### **Joint Iloilo City-Guimaras ICP**

- Set up Incident Command Post situated at City Mall Parola Wharf.
- Continuous monitoring of the incident.

#### **PDRRMC Guimaras**

- Conducted Coordination Meeting with the Local Chief Executives of Sibunag, Jordan,
- Nueva Valencia, and Buenavista re the incident and actions to be taken.
- Coordinated with PCG re list of passengers aboard in order to come up with a master list.
- Coordinated with hospitals in Guimaras and Iloilo City re status of patients.
- Global Communicators and Warning Network.
- Provided communications network between OCD VI and Joint Iloilo City-Guimaras.
- Incident Command Post.



- Provided transportation vehicles that shall transport passengers who travelled thru RORO from Iloilo City.
- Provided financial aid to Guimaras victims and for casualties and survivors under medication.
- Facilitated transport of passengers from RORO Wharf to Province of Guimaras vice-versa.
- Deployment of personnel to various wharves together with DSWD-QRT Staff.
- Facilitated transport of medical personnel to Guimaras.
- Facilitated settlement of bills of casualties brought to Gegato-Abecia Funeral Homes.
- Attended the meeting with LGUs together with DOH representatives at the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) and discussed the following:
  - Assistance to be provided
  - Validation of casualties and victims
  - Augmentation of DOH doctors from Iloilo for MHPSS
  - Formation of teams for MHPSS.

#### **PDRRMC Palawan**

- Shouldered the expenses for the transport of victim from Palawan and the bereaved family.

#### **CDRRMC Iloilo City, Iloilo**

- Set up of evacuation center at the Diamond Jubilee Hall.
- Provided hot meals for the strandeds.
- Activated Response Cluster and Local Incident Management Team, Emergency Response Services together with BFP, Guimaras EMS, Navy, Reserve/UKC 600M, PSTMO, PNP and volunteer rescue groups ICAG, FedFire.
- Facilitated the transfer of the stranded passengers from City Mall to RORO Wharf Lapuz.
- Facilitated the travel of 1,600 stranded passengers from RORO Wharf to Guimaras.
- Iloilo City Government provided financial aid to non-Iloilo City victims: Php 10,000.00 for families of dead casualties and Php 5,000.00 for the survivors.
- Provided financial aid to Iloilo City victims: Php 50,000.00 for families of dead casualties and Php 5,000.00 for the survivors.
- Provided tents for RORO passengers travelling from Iloilo to Guimaras at Lapuz Wharf.
- Dispatched two (2) ambulance teams to assist in the transfer of the retrieved bodies found in Dumangas Strait to Gegato Funeral Homes.
- Facilitated fast tracking of essential documents and scheduling of autopsy for dead casualties.

#### **CSWDO Iloilo**

- Mobilized social workers for response activities.



- Provided continuous psychosocial intervention both at the Diamond Jubilee Hall and PAROLA area.
- Facilitated the health check-ups of some survivors.

#### **Iloilo City Police Office**

- Deployed personnel at the Parola Fast Craft Terminal and RORO Wharf to maintain security and safety of stranded passengers.
- Established Police Assistance Desks and assisted in the distribution of food packs.

#### **Bureau of Fire Protection-Iloilo City**

- Assisted in the transportation of stranded passengers particularly those with special medical attention.
- Provided an ambulance team in case of emergency medical services need by the victims.

#### **MDRRMO Dumangas, Iloilo**

- Assisted search and retrieval operations at Dumangas Port.

#### **Citymall**

- Parola provided facility for Joint Iloilo- Guimaras ICP.


