PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 pm today, the center of Tropical Storm "ONYOK" was estimated based on all available data at 980 km east northeast of baler, aurora or 945 km east of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan (17.3°n, 130.6°e) with maximum sustained winds of 75 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 90 km/h. It is moving northwest at 35 km/h
