#### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the center of **Severe Tropical Storm "ONYOK"** was estimated based on all available data at **605 km east of Tuguegarao City**, **Cagayan (18.0 °N, 127.4 °E)** with maximum sustained winds of **95 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **115 km/h**. It is moving West at **30 km/h**.
