#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM, 28 October 2019, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 220 km East Southeast of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (9.3 °N, 120.7 °E). This LPA is expected to develop into a Tropical Depression within 24 to 36 hours. This LPA will bring light to moderate with intermittent heavy rains over Bicol Region, MIMAROPA, Aurora, and Quezon. Residents in these areas are advised to take precautionary measures against possible flashfloods in low lying areas and landslides over mountainous areas.

The public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management offices concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates to be incorporated in the Public Weather Forecast at 4:00 PM, 28 October 2019 and 4:00 AM, 29 October 2019. The next weather advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM, 29 October 2019.
