I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM, 29 October 2019, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 470 km West Northwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (11.7 °N, 114.9 °E) (Outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility). This LPA is expected to develop into a Tropical Depression within 6 to 12 hours. Light to moderate with intermittent heavy rains will be experienced over Central Luzon, CALABARZON, and MIMAROPA. Residents in these areas are advised to take precautionary measures against possible flashfloods in low lying areas and landslides over mountainous areas.

With this development, this is the final advisory.

The public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management offices concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates to be incorporated in the Public Weather Forecast at 4:00 PM, 29 October 2019 and 4:00 AM, 30 October 2019.
