## STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

SEABOARDS	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH / KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE NORTHERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Calayan, Babuyan and Northern coast of Ilocos Norte)	Cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms	45-68 / 24-36	Rough to very rough	2.8-5.0
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON (Aurora, Quezon including Polilio Island, Camarines Provinces, and Catanduanes)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	45-68 / 24-36	Rough to very rough	2.8-5.0
THE WESTERN SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON (Ilocos Sur, La Union, Pangasinan, and Western Coast of Ilocos Norte)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	45-68 / 24-36	Rough to very rough	2.8-5.0

Fishing boats and other small seacraft are advised not to venture out into the sea while larger sea vessels are alerted against big waves.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the Public, and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this advisory through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
