STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

THE NORTHERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Calayan, Babuyan and Northern coast of Ilocos Norte)	Cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms	45-68 / 24-36	Rough to very rough	2.8-5.0
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON (Aurora, Quezon including Polilio Island, Camarines Provinces, and Catanduanes)	Cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms	45-68 / 24-36	Rough to very rough	2.8-5.0
THE WESTERN SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON (Ilocos Sur, La Union, Pangasinan, and Western Coast of Ilocos Norte)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	45-68 / 24-36	Rough to very rough	2.8-5.0
