1. Initial report re Vehicular Accident in Purok Matinumanun, Brgy. Alianza, Bago City, Negros Occidental (OCDRO VI)

A. Situation Overview

On 14 November 2019, 06:28 PM, a vehicular accident involving two Roadstar Buses with the same routes collided with one another.

B. Effects

A total of sixteen (16) passengers were injured in the collision:

OCDRO VI

- Coordinated with CDRRMO Bago regarding the incident.
- Continuous monitoring of the AOR.

CDRRMO Bago

- Coordinated with Ma-ao Volunteer Response Unit (MAVRU) for augmentation.
- Dispatched Emergency Medical Service 3 and Search And Rescue team 3, with two (2) emergency response vehicles.
- Triage done with the triage officer, treated the patients with injuries.
- Coordinated with Bago City Hospital (BCH).
- Transported patients to BCH together with MAVRU.
