#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Low Pressure Area (LPA) west of Luzon has developed into a Tropical Depression.

Location of Center (3:00 AM today)	The center of Tropical Depression was estimated based on all available data at 610 km West Southwest of Iba, Zambales (OUTSIDE PAR)(13.6°N,114.6°E)
Maximum Sustained Winds	45 km/h near the center
Gustiness	Up to 55 km/h
Movement	Almost Stationary

The LPA developed into a Tropical Depression (TD) at 2:00 AM today. The TD is expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) within 24 hours and will be named "QUIEL". The trough of the TD and the Frontal system

will bring scattered light to moderate rains with at times heavy rains (during thunderstorms) over Ilocos Region, Cagayan, Apayao, Batanes, Palawan, Zambales, and Bataan. The TD is less likely to make landfall in any part of the country. The TD may intensify into a Tropical Storm (TS) within 24 hrs.

The public and the disaster risk reduction and management council concerned are advised to monitor for the next advisory at 11 AM Today.
