### **PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **3:00 AM** today, the center of Severe Tropical Storm "SARAH" (FUNG-WONG) was estimated based on all available data at **335 km Northeast** of Basco, Batanes (**22.3 °N, 124.5 °E**), with maximum sustained winds of **95 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **115 km/h**. It is moving **North** at **20 km/h**. Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) (formerly "RAMON") was estimated based on all available data at **665 km West Southwest** of Subic, Zambales or **560 km West of Coron, Palawan (11.6 °N, 115.1 °E)**.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio

stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
