### **PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "Ramon" (Kalmaegi) was estimated based on all available data at **290 km East Northeast of Casiguran, Aurora (16.8° N, 124.8° E)** with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 80 km/h. It is moving west at **15 KPH**. Northeast monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.

### **No. 07 for Region II (Cagayan Valley)**

People living near the mountain slopes and low-lying areas near the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are still advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
