PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "Ramon" (Kalmaegi) was estimated based on all available data at 490 km East of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan (16.9° N, 126.3° E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 80 km/h. It remains almost stationary. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.
