PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "Ramon" (Kalmaegi) was estimated based on all available data at 205 km East Northeast of Casiguran, Aurora (17.2° N, 123.8° E) with maximum sustained winds of 85 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 105 km/h. It is moving west at 10 km/h.
