III. DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

A. NATIONAL DRRM COUNCIL (NDRRMC)

NDRRM Operations Center (NDRRMOC)

- Maintained BLUE ALERT status.
- Prepared the Emergency Alert Warning Message (EAWM) and forwarded to Telecommunication Companies for dissemination to the affected areas.
- Continuous coordination with partner agencies and regional offices for response actions.

Department of Health Emergency Alert Reporting System (DOH-HEARS)

- Coordinated with Centers for Health Development (CHD) X, XI, and XII regarding the monitored incident.
- Continuous coordination with DOST-PHIVOLCS for updates.
- Deployed Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) Team of CHD X in 17 barangays together with BFP, PNP, and Philippine Army to assess the damages incurred in the different affected areas.

B. Regional DRRM Council (RDRRMC)

Office of Civil Defense X (OCD X)

- Coordinated with PDRRMO Bukidnon and MDRRMO Kadingilan, Dangcagan, Damulog, Don Carlos, Kitaotao and CDRRMO Valencia City relative to the incident.

- Continued monitoring of the incident.

PDRRMO Bukidnon

- Coordinated with Municipal DRRMOs in the Province of Bukidnon to confirm and gather data about the incident.

MDRRMO Dangacan, Damulog, Kadingilan, and CDRRMO Valencia City

- On-going assessment within respective AOR for any damages brought about by the earthquake.
