STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

SEABOARDS	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH / KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Cagayan including Babuyan Islands, Isabela, Ilocos Norte, and Ilocos Sur)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	45-63 / 24-36	Rough to very rough	2.8-4.5

Fishing boats and other small seacraft are advised not to venture out into the sea while larger sea vessels are alerted against big waves.

The next update will be issued at 23 November 2019, 5:00 AM.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the Public, and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this advisory through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
