MODERATE TO STRONG WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

SEABOARDS	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH / KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Cagayan including Babuyan Islands, Isabela, Ilocos Norte, and Ilocos Sur)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	30-52 / 16-28	Moderate to rough	1.2-3.4

This is the FINAL GALE WARNING.

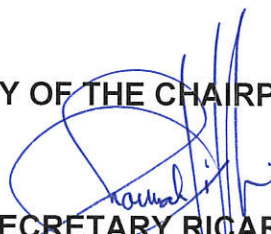
