Present Weather:

At 3:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon URSULA (PHANFONE) was located based on all available data including Guiuan Doppler Radar at 50 km Northeast of Guiuan Eastern Samar (11.4 °N, 126.0 °E), with maximum sustained winds of up to 120 km/h near the center and gustiness up to 150 km/h. It is moving West at 25 km/h.
