No. 02 for Region XI (Davao Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.
WATER COURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and its tributaries particularly: Davao Del Sur - Davao, Talomo, Lipadas, Tagulaya Sibulan, Digos and Padada Mainit. Davao Oriental - Cateel, Dapnan, Baganga Mahan-Ub, Manorigao, Caraga, Casauman, Quinonoan, Bagwan, Mayo, Bitanayan, Sumlog, Tangmoan, Dacongbonwa, Kabasagan, Manay, Maya and Sumlao/Cuabo. Compostela Valley - Matibo and Hijo. Davao Del Norte - Tagum-Libuganon, Tuganay, Saug and Lasang. Davao Occidental - Panglan, Malita, Batanan (Lais, Lawan, Latuan, Calian, Lamita, Lawayon, Culama, Caburan Bi, Maubio, Karabana, Tubayo, Kayapung, Malala, Capisolo, Tanoman Bi, Tanoman Smal, Kalbay,

No. 02 for Region XII (SOCCSKSARGEN)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.
WATER COURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and its tributaries particularly: Sarangani - Kalaong, Buayan-Malungan, Little-Lun, Big-Lun and Gian. Sultan Kudarat - Tian and Kraan. North Cotabato - Libungan, Malasila, Toliman-Dunakling, Maridagao, Kabacan, Mulita, Alkan, Kulaman, Upper Mlang and Pulanggi. South Cotabato - Siquil, Makar and Banaga.

No. 05 for Region XIII (CARAGA)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.
WATER COURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and its tributaries particularly: Surigao Del Norte – Surigao Aand Magallanes Agusan Del Sur – Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan. Agusan Del Norte – Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran. Surigao Del Sur – Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low-lying areas of the abovementioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are still advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
