### PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "TISOY" {KAMMURI} WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 380 KM WEST OF SUBIC, ZAMBALES (14.5 °N, 116.8 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 95 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 115 KM/H. IT IS MOVING WEST NORTHWEST AT 20 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.
