PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM "TISOY" {KAMMURI} WAS AT 540 KM WEST OF SUBIC, ZAMBALES (14.8 °N, 115.3 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 65 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80 KM/H. IT IS MOVING WEST NORTHWEST AT 15 KM/H. TAIL-END OF A COLD FRONT AFFECTING THE EASTERN SECTION OF NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING THE REST OF NORTHERN LUZON.

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasional heavy rains.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: AURORA - Particularly Casiguran, Aguang and Lower Umiray.
