No. 3 for Region III (Central Luzon)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasional moderate rains.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• AURORA - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY CASIGURAN, AGUANG AND LOWER UMIRAY.
