INTERTROPICAL CONVERGENCE ZONE (ITCZ) AFFECTING PALWAN AND MINDANAO. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON

TUPILAC, LABANGAN AND MAPANGI ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE - PARTICULARLY PARODAPITAN, DIPOLOG, DIKAYA, GOLID DUWAIT, SINDANGAN, INGIN (MARAS), PALANDOC, BUCAS, PATAUG, QUIPIT, SIOCON, PIACAN, ANUNGAN, PANGAMIRAN AND SIBUCON
