Present Weather:

At 3:00 AM today, the low pressure area (LPA) was estimated at 795 km east Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (5.9 °n, 133.1 °e). Trough of LPA affecting the Northeastern section of Mindanao.

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasionally moderate rains and thunderstorms
WATER COURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and its tributaries particularly: Surigao Del Norte – Surigao and Magallanes Agusan Del Sur – Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan. Agusan Del Norte – Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran. Surigao Del Sur – Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the abovementioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are still advised to be alert for possible flash floods and landslides.
