#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**

On 27 December 2019, 3:00 AM, the eye of Typhoon "URSULA" was located based on all available data at 335 km West of Subic, Zambales (14.5 °N, 117.2 °E), with maximum sustained winds of 120 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 150 km/h. It is moving Northwest at 10 km/h. Tail-end of a Cold Front affecting Northern Luzon.

#### **II. EFFECTS**

##### **A. Casualties**

**A total of 28 dead, 2 injured, and 12 missing** (Previous report: 21 dead and 10 missing) were reported in Regions VI, VII, and VIII due to TY "URSULA".
