I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

"URSULA" SLIGHTLY WEAKENS AND NOW OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY

On 28 December 2019, 10:00 AM, the center of Tropical Storm "URSULA" was estimated based on all available data 595 km West of Subic, Zambales (outside PAR) (14.5°N, 114.8°E), with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 80 km/h. It is moving West Southwest at 10km/h

Tropical Storm "URSULA" is no longer directly affecting the country. However, the Tail-End of a Cold Front will bring scattered light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms over Cordillera Administrative Region, Cagayan Valley, and Aurora this morning.

Sea travel is risky, especially for small seacrafts, over the seaboard of Northern Luzon due to rough seas caused by the surge of the Northeast Monsoon.

"URSULA" exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) on 28 December 2019, 9:50 AM.

II. EFFECTS

A. Incidents Monitored

FIRE INCIDENT

1. On 24 December 2019, 8:57 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 66, Paseo de Legaspi, Tacloban City. Investigation revealed that an unattended candle due to power outage caused the incident. A total of 24 families / 99 persons were affected while a total of 10 residential houses made of light materials were damaged due to the incident. The affected families are temporarily staying in Anibong Elementary School in Brgy. Anibong, Tacloban City. One person was reported injured due to 2nd and 3rd degree flare burns.

CAPSIZED INCIDENTS

2. On 25 December 2019, 3:45 AM, a motorbanca named "MARVIN KRISTOPHER" with 14 crew capsized in the vicinity of Brgy. Maujao, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro due to strong winds. The 3 crew were reported dead while the 11 others managed to swim towards the coast of Brgy. Maujao.

3. On 25 December 2019, 11:00 AM, fishing boats namely "ATHAN 3" and "ATHAN 4" were last seen in the vicinity of Brgy. Caminawit, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro with three (3) personnel on board. The said fishing boats believed to have damaged during the onslaught of "TY URSULA" and three (3) personnel were reported missing since then. As of reporting time, one (1) victim was found dead in the vicinity waters of Brgy. Ansiray, Ilin, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro while the two (2) other victims are still missing.

C. Affected Population (TAB A)

- A total of **399,242 families / 1,633,611 persons** (previous report: 346,217 families / 1,437,343 persons) were affected in **2,044 barangays** (previous report: 1,595 barangays) in Regions MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII and CARAGA.
- Of which, a total of **24,378 families / 97,503 persons** (previous report: 21,939 families / 89,324 persons) are taking temporary shelter in **529 evacuation centers** (previous report: 365 ECs) while **8,717 families / 38,049 persons** (previous report: 7,905 families / 34,642 persons) are served outside ECs.

D. Damage to Infrastructure

A total of **372 schools were partially damaged** (previous report: 158 schools) in Regions CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, and VIII.

Damaged Houses (TAB B.2)

A total of **265,643 damaged houses** (previous report: 253,345 damaged houses) were reported in Regions MIMAROPA, VI, VII, and VIII. Of which, **36,130 were totally damaged while 229,513 were partially damaged**. (previous report: 34,943 totally damaged while 218,402 were partially damaged).

G. Status of Lifelines

Power Supply (TAB D)

A total of **151 cities/municipalities** (previous report: 150 cities/municipalities) experienced power outage in Regions MIMAROPA, VI, VII, and VIII. Of which, power in **38 cities/municipalities** were already restored.

Roads and Bridges (TAB E)

- Conducted clearing operations at Brgy Abuyog, Cagangon, Catagbacan in the Municipality of Burauen, Leyte on 25 December 2019.
- Conducted RDANA and aerial survey utilizing 1 NOMAD aircraft to OCD VIII and two 2 helicopters to OCD VI on 26 and 27 December 2019.
- Conducted SRR Operations of the 4 missing Fisherman utilizing 1 NOMAD aircraft and SAR helicopter on 26 December 2019.
- Provided NOMAD aircraft, 4 UH-1H/D helicopter and 1 Huey II SAR Helicopter to CENTCOM to conduct HADR Operations.

- c. Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) personnel is rendering duty at DSWD OpCen.
- d. Regional Resource Operation Section (RROS) dispatched FFPs for Babatngon, Leyte, has ongoing repacking of FFPs and preparing the FFPs requested by various affected LGUs.
