MODERATE TO STRONG WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

THE NORTHERN AND EASTERN SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON AND THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF CENTRAL LUZON (Batanes, Cagayan including Babuyan Islands, Isabela, northern coast of Ilocos Norte, and Aurora)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	(32 - 41) (17 - 22)	Moderate to Rough	1.5 – 2.5
THE EASTERN SEABOARDS OF SOUTHERN LUZON (Northern Quezon, northern and eastern coast of Polillo Islands, Camarines Norte, the northern coast of Camarines Sur, the eastern coast of Sorsogon, and the northern and eastern coast of Catanduanes)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	(36 - 41) (19 - 22)	Moderate to Rough	2.0 - 2.5
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF VISAYAS (Northern Samar and Eastern Samar)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	(36 - 41) (19 - 22)	Moderate to Rough	2.0 - 2.5
