No. 02 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • LEYTE – Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan, and Binahaan. • EASTERN SAMAR – Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat. • SOUTHERN LEYTE – Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. • NORTHERN SAMAR – Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Maou and Gamay. • BILIRAN – All Rivers and tributaries. • SAMAR – Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan.

No. 03 for Region IV - A CALABARZON

Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island), and Upper Kilbay – catabangan.

No. 11 for Region VII (Central Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • NEGROS ORIENTAL - Libertad, Tanjay, Candugay, Siaton, Cauitan, Sipocong, Bayawan, Pagatban and Lower Tyabanan. • CEBU – Kotkot, Mananga, Guinabasan, Balamban and Sapang Dako. • BOHOL – Inabanga, Ipil, Matulid, Loboc and Abatan.

People living near the mountain slopes and low-lying areas near the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are **still advised to take necessary precautionary measures**.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
