STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS IS EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

SEABOARD	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH / KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE NORTHERN SEABOARD OF LUZON (Batanes, Calayan, Babuyan, Cagayan, Isabela, Ilocos Norte)	Cloudy skies with light rains	(52 - 63) / (28 - 34)	Rough to very rough	3.4 to 4.5
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON (Aurora, Eastern coast of Quezon including Polillo Island, Camarines Norte, northern and eastern coast of Camarines Sur and Catanduanes)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and isolated thunderstorms	(52 - 63) / (28 - 34)	Rough to very rough	3.4 to 4.5

Fishing boats and other small sea crafts are advised not to venture out into the sea while larger sea vessels are alerted against big waves.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
