STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS HAS WEAKENED

SEABOARDS	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH / KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF VISAYAS (The coasts of Samar and Leyte)	Cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms	(30-45) / (16-24)	Moderate to rough	1.25 to 3.0
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF MINDANAO (The coast of Davao Oriental)	Partly cloudy skies to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	(30-40) / (16-22)	Moderate	1.25 to 2.5
