<b>THE SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN and CENTRAL LUZON</b> (Batanes, Calayan, Babuyan, Cagayan, Ilocos Norte, Isabela, Ilocos Sur, La Union, Pangasinan, Aurora, Zambales and Bataan)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	(52-63)/(28-34)	Rough to Very Rough	3.4 to 4.5
<b>THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF SOUTHERN LUZON AND OF VISAYAS</b> (Camarines Provinces, Catanduanes, eastern coast of Albay, eastern coast of Sorsogon, eastern coast of Quezon including Polilio Island and <b>eastern coast of Samar Provinces</b> )	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and isolated thunderstorms	(52-63)/(28-34)	Rough to Very Rough	3.4 to 4.5
