Strong to gale force winds is expected to affect the following areas:

THE NORTHERN AND WESTERN SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Calayan, Babuyan, Ilocos Norte, Northern coast of Cagayan)	Cloudy Skies With Light Rains	(52–63) / (28-34)	Rough To Very Rough	3.4 to 4.5
THE WESTERN AND SOUTHERN SEABOARDS OF SOUTHERN LUZON (Southern coast of Mindoro provinces, Northern Palawan)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	(52–63) / (28-34)	Rough To Very Rough	3.4 to 4.5
