AREAS:**

<b>THE SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON AND EASTERN SEABOARD OF CENTRAL LUZON</b> (Batanes, Calayan, Babuyan, Cagayan, Ilocos Norte, Isabela and Aurora)	Cloudy skies with light rains	(52-63) / (28-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
<b>THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF SOUTHERN LUZON</b> (Eastern coast of Quezon including Polilio Island and Camarines Provinces)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	(52-63) / (28-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
