**STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS IS EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:**

<b>THE SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON AND EASTERN SEABOARD OF CENTRAL LUZON</b> (Batanes, <b>Calayan</b> , Babuyan, Cagayan, Ilocos Norte, Isabela and Aurora)	Cloudy skies with light rains	(52-63) / (28-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
<b>THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF SOUTHERN LUZON AND OF VISAYAS</b> (Catanduanes, Northern and eastern seaboard of Camarines Provinces, Eastern coast of Albay, Eastern coast of Sorsogon, Eastern coast of Quezon including Polilio Island, Northern and eastern coast of Northern Samar and <b>Eastern coast of Eastern Samar</b> )	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	(52-63) / (28-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5


