**STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS IS EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING
AREAS:**

THE NORTHERN and EASTERN SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON AND EASTERN SEABOARD OF CENTRAL LUZON (Batanes, Babuyan, Cagayan, northern coast of Ilocos Norte , Isabela and Aurora)	Cloudy skies with light rains	(52-63) / (28-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF SOUTHERN LUZON (Catanduanes, Northern Quezon including Polillo Island and northern and eastern seabords of Camarines Provinces)	Mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	(52-63) / (28-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 – 4.5
