**STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS IS EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:**

SEABOARD	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH / KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE SEABOARD OF NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON (Batanes, Calayan, Babuyan, Ilocos Provinces, Cagayan and Isabela, La Union, Pangasinan, Aurora, and Zambales)	Cloudy skies with light rains	(45 - 68) / (24 - 36)	Rough to very rough	2.8 - 5.0
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF SOUTHERN LUZON (Catanduanes, Northern Quezon including Polillo Island and Northern and Eastern Seabords of Camarines Provinces)	Mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	(45 - 68) / (24 - 36)	Rough to very rough	2.8 - 5.0
