<b>THE NORTHERN AND EASTERN SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON</b> (Batanes, Babuyan Group of Islands, Cagayan, and Isabela)	Cloudy skies with scattered rains	(45-63)/(24-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
<b>THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON</b> (Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union, and Pangasinan)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rains	(45-63)/(24-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
<b>THE NORTHERN AND EASTERN SEABOARDS OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON</b> (Aurora, Quezon including Polillo Island, Camarines Norte, Northern Camarines Sur, and Catanduanes)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	(45-63)/(24-34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
