I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on available data at 615km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.2 deg N, 131.9 deg E). This weather system will bring light to moderate with intermittent heavy rains over CARAGA and Eastern Visayas.

Residents in the aforementioned areas, especially those living in highly susceptible to flooding and rain-induced landslides are advised to take appropriate actions. Coordinate with Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices (LDRRMO) and continue monitoring for updates including thunderstorms or rainfall advisories and heavy rainfall warnings issued by PAGASA Regional Services Division.

The next advisory on this weather disturbance will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.
