I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

A. Volcanic Earthquake

A total of **690 volcanic earthquakes** were plotted in Taal region as of **5:00 AM**. Of which, **175 were felt**, ranging from **Magnitude 1.2 – 4.1 and Intensity of I – V**.

If the eruption column remains at **5 km** or below, the ash plumes will be drifted to the municipalities south and southwest of Taal Volcano. However, if a major eruption occurs within the forecast period and the column exceeds **5 km**, ash plumes will also be drifted over the **eastern** and **northeastern** portions of Batangas and **Laguna**.

II. EFFECTS

A. Affected Population

- A total **22,472 families / 96,061 persons** were affected in the Batangas, Laguna, and Cavite. Of which, a total of **16,174 families / 70,413 persons** are taking temporary shelter in **300 evacuation centers**

- The LGUs of Alitagtag, Balayan, Batangas City, Bauan, Calatagan, Lian, Lipa, Malvar, Nasugbu, Rosario, San Jose, San Luis, San Pascual, Santa Teresita, Sto. Tomas, and Tuy in Batangas; Alfonso, Indang, Maragondon, Mendez (MENDEZ-NUÑEZ), Tagaytay City, and Ternate in Cavite; Cabuyao and City of Calamba in Laguna; and Candelaria, Dolores, Gumaca, Perez, San Antonio, Sariaya, and Tiaong in Quezon hosted IDPs from affected municipalities.

B. Status of Lifelines

Roads

Officials, PNP, Marikina Fire Rescue, Bahay Partylist, and Civilian at Paaralang Elementarya ng Muzon conducted repacking of relief goods and assisted in receiving, distributing of relief goods, and feeding the evacuees.

4. Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)

Deployed staff in DSWD FO- CALABARZON to escort and distribute goods to ECs in San Pascual, Batangas.

5. Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG)

CODIX is continuously monitoring reports from concerned DILG Regional Offices and LGUs re preparedness and response actions for Taal Volcano eruption operations.

6. Department of Education (DepEd)

- a. DepEd Pasig City distributed relief packs to 10 schools used as evacuation centers in Batangas;
- b. DepEd San Jose City provided relief goods to DepEd Batangas;
- c. DepEd Region V released memorandum for deployment of personnel to provide augmentation to the response efforts for affected divisions in CALABARZON.
- d. Provided assistance (hygiene kits, emergency school feeding, PFA, TLS, learning materials, etc.) to affected learners and personnel by various offices in the Central Office and field offices.
- e. Established child protection mechanisms for internally displaced learners.
- f. Continuous generation of donations from regions/divisions and partners.
- g. Provided Alternative Delivery Modes (ADM) of education or curriculum-related interventions.

7. Department of Health (DOH)

- a. Mobilized a total of 31 Health Emergency Response / Emergency Medical Teams from the 4 CHDs, 16 DOH Hospitals, and 1 LGU.
- b. Dr. Jose N. Rodriguez Memorial Hospital and Sanitarium PEMAT set-up a Type 1 Fixed Mobile Hospital along Barangay Caloocan in Balayan, Batangas.
- c. Placed MIMAROPA CHD Public Health team on standby for possible deployment.
- d. Attended the Batangas Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Response Cluster Meeting for Taal Operations on 17 January 2020 with DRRM-H Managers of CALABARZON CHD and Bicol CHD.

8. Philippine National Police (PNP)

19 January 2020

- a. A total of 1,842 SAR Personnel were deployed in the affected areas while 9,960 SAR Personnel were placed on standby for possible deployment.
- b. Deployed a total of 1,903 PNP personnel in evacuation areas.
- c. At 5:30 AM, SAF personnel onboard 1 SAF Bus, 3 Heavy Troop Carriers (MAN Trucks), 1 SWAT Van, 8 Light Troop Carriers and 2 Ambulances left HSAF, Camp Bagong Diwa, Bicutan, Taguig City and proceeded to Batangas Sports Complex, Bolbok, Batangas to conduct rescue and relief operations.
- d. At 5:30 AM, PBI with 7 policewomen of RSSF, NHQ rendered assistance in the food preparation of Talisay MPS, 19 from Rizal PPO and 19 from RSSF, NHQ rendering a 24-rotation duty at the 3 lock down area of Talisay MPS.
- e. At 5:30 AM, 7 members of Reactionary Standby Support, NHQ provided assistance in the food preparation of Talisay MPS. Meanwhile, 19 personnel from Rizal PPO and 19 personnel from RSSF, NHQ are rendering a 24-hour duty in 3 lock down areas of Talisay MPS.
- f. At 8:00 AM, PNP Chaplain Service personnel headed to Sto. Tomas Batangas Gymnasium to distribute relief goods to the victims of Taal Volcano eruption onboard 7 vehicles and 2 Motorcycle escorts from Highway Patrol Group (HPG).
- g. At 8:30 AM, SAF personnel distributed relief packs to the evacuees.

- h. At 6:00 AM, Legal Service Reactionary Standby Support Force (LS RSSF) provided assistance in the preparation of the Rosario East Elem School Multi-purpose Hall as venue for the medical mission of NCRPO.
- i. At 6:30 AM, Police Community Affairs and Development Group (PCADG) personnel proceeded to San Juan and Lipa City, Batangas to facilitate the distribution of relief goods.
- j. At 7:25 AM, Director of Special Action Force (SAF) together with SAF Personnel arrived at Batangas Sports Complex, Brgy. Bolbok, Batangas City for the distribution of 500 packs of relief goods and to conduct Medical and Dental mission to the evacuees.
- k. At 7:45 AM, Civil Security Group Reactionary Standby Support Force (CSG-RSSF) conducted clean-up drive at Indang Central Elementary School evacuation center.
