I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

A. Volcanic Earthquake

A total of **701 volcanic earthquakes** were plotted in Taal region as of 19 January 2020, **6:00 PM**. Of which, **176** were felt, ranging from **Magnitude 1.2 – 4.1** and **Intensity of I – V**.

If the eruption column remains at **3.0 km** or below, the ash plumes will be drifted to the municipalities **southwest and west** of Taal Volcano. However, if a major eruption occurs within the forecast period and the column exceeds **5 km**, ash plumes will also be drifted over the **Metro Manila, Laguna, and some parts of Rizal and northern Quezon**.

II. EFFECTS

A. Affected Population

- A total **50,599 families / 203,763 persons** were affected in the Batangas, Quezon, Laguna, and Cavite.
- Of which, a total of **26,767 families / 104,377 persons** are taking temporary shelter in **408 evacuation centers** while **17,391 families / 68,755 persons** are served outside ECs.

NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS SITREP

- The LGUs of Alitagtag, Balayan, Batangas City, Bauan, Calatagan, Lian, Lipa, Malvar, Nasugbu, Rosario, San Jose, San Luis, San Pascual, Santa Teresita, Sto. Tomas, and Tuy in Batangas; Alfonso, Indang, Maragondon, Mendez (Mendez- Nuñez), Tagaytay City, and Ternate in Cavite; Cabuyao and City of Calamba in Laguna; and Candelaria, Dolores, Gumaca, Perez, San Antonio, Sariaya, and Tiaong in Quezon hosted IDPs from affected municipalities.

- a. Human Rights Affairs Office (HRAO) and Health Service (HS) together with San Jose City Police Station (SJPCS) personnel provided assistance to San Jose LGU in the distribution of relief goods and food provisions to the evacuees.
- b. Maritime Group Reactionary Standby Support Force (MG RSSF), Finance Service Reactionary Standby Support Force (FS RSSF) and Taal Municipal Police Station (TMPS) provided assistance in the repacking of relief goods donated by Knights of Columbus at Brgy. - a. Delivered relief goods at Lumbang Evacuation Center together with the Director of Police Community Affairs and Development Group (PCADG).

1. RDRRMC II

Police Regional Office (PRO) II

Police Regional Office II thru their Regional Director, collected 144 sacks of rice coming from Regional Headquarters, Police Provincial Office and Santiago Police Station for the Victim of Taal Volcano Eruption. The said sacks of rice were loaded to PRO II 6x6 truck and have been transported to Batangas PPO prior to its distribution to different evacuation centers.

2. RDRRMC CALABARZON

BFP CALABARZON

Affected Fire Stations were transferred to other location to provide continuous service to affected victims.

Police Regional Office (PRO) CALABARZON

- a. Alfonso Municipal Police Station (AMPS) established Police Assistance Desk (PAD) at Alfonso Central School to provide assistance and security to the evacuees from Laurel and Lemery, Batangas.
- b. Silang Municipal Police Station (SMPS) and Members of Guardian GSSI Chapter provided assistance in the distribution of relief goods among the evacuees/victims of volcano eruption at Brgy. Malabag Silang Cavite.
- c. Taal Municipal Police Station (TMPS) and Naval Special Operation Unit (NAVSOG) conducted preventive mobile patrol for the implementation of Mandatory evacuation/lockdown in Taal, Batangas.

Center for Health Development (CHD) CALABARZON

- a. Facilitated an Orientation and Stakeholders Meeting with CHD Region II for Quad Cluster deployment.
- b. Deployed medical and response teams at the affected Provinces to conduct health assessment, data collection, and provide needed assistance.
- c. Accounted and monitored the total number of families and individuals including other pertinent health information per evacuation center.
- d. Provided needed and requested logistics such as drugs and other supplies.
- e. Continuous coordination with other agencies at the Regional level, Provincial DOH Offices, PDRRMOs, and other stakeholder for the continuity of health responses to the affected provinces.

Department of Public Works and Highway

- a. Continuous conduct of clearing operations of national roads in Batangas and Cavite.
- b. Provided transportation for relief goods from NFA Office, Batangas to Cuenca Central School and as well as from Batangas City to Balete, Batangas.
- c. Relocated evacuees from Tanauan North Elementary School to Tanauan City Evacuation Center.

DSWD CALABARZON

- a. Ongoing distribution of family food packs are being conducted by FO Staff to the evacuation centers in Cabuyao and San Antonio, Laguna, and Balete and San Pascual, Batangas.
- b. Conducted a meeting with PIMT to address the congestion of 163 IDPs at the Provincial Sports Complex outside the dome.
- c. Conducted a meeting regarding the preparations for the President's visit at the Evacuation Centers in Sto. Tomas, Batangas.
