#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**

##### **A. Volcanic Earthquake**

A total of **950 volcanic earthquakes** were plotted in Taal region as of **24 January 2020, 8:00 AM**. Of which, 176 were felt, ranging from Magnitude 1.2 – 4.1 and Intensity of I – V.

If the eruption column remains at 5.0 km or below, the ash plumes will be drifted to the municipalities west and northwest of Taal Volcano. However, if a major eruption occurs within the forecast period and the column exceeds 7.0 km, ash plumes may also be drifted over western parts of Laguna and Quezon.

## II. EFFECTS

### A. Affected Population

- A total **88,842 families / 346,244 persons** were affected in the Provinces of Batangas, Quezon, Laguna, and Cavite.
- Of which, a total of **37,311 / 137,538 persons** are taking temporary shelter in **488 evacuation centers** while **37,230 families / 144,907 persons** are served outside ECs.
- The LGUs of Alitagtag, Balayan, Batangas City, Bauan, Calatagan, Ibaan, Lian, Lipa City, Lobo, Malvar, Nasugbu, Padre Garcia, Rosario, San Jose, San Juan, San Luis, San Pascual, Santa Teresita, Sto. Tomas, Taysan, and Tuy in Batangas; Alfonso, Amadeo, Dasmariñas, General Emilio Aguinaldo, Indang, Maragondon, Mendez (Mendez- Nuñez), Naic, Silang, Tagaytay City, and Ternate in Cavite; Alaminos, Bay, Cabuyao, City of Calamba, Cavinti, Kalayaan, Los Baños, Magdalena, Nagcarlan, San Pablo City, Santa Cruz, and City of Sta. Rosa in Laguna; Candelaria, Dolores, Gumaca, Infanta, Pagbilao, Pitogo, San Antonio, Sariaya, and Tiaong in Quezon; and Caloocan, Malabon, Manila, Muntinlupa, Parañaque, Taguig, Quezon City, and San Juan City in NCR hosted IDPs from affected municipalities.

- a. Provided transportation assistance to 2,500 evacuees from Paaralang Sentral ng Mataas na Kahoy to Dr. Juan A Pastor Memorial National High School, Ibaan, Batangas.
- b. Provided manpower assistance during the unloading of relief goods (sacks of rice) from private organization at Mataas na Kahoy, Batangas and assisted PNP, together with BFP, in the forced evacuation at Barangay Alangilan, Balete.
- c. Provided transportation assistance to the evacuees at Sta Cruz, Agoncillo and rescued 1 disabled civilian from his residence at Lemery, Batangas and turned over to his relatives.
- d. Provided continuous construction of temporary latrines at main evacuation center, Poblacion 3, Sto Tomas, Batangas.

- a. Conducted joint security checkpoint with PNP at Brgy Banjo West, Tanauan City, Batangas and Brgy Niyugan, Laurel, Batangas.

- g. Assisted in the feeding of evacuees inside Alitagtag Gymnasium and assisted the team from 1st AFP Affiliated Medical Reserve Unit in hauling of relief goods.

- b. Continuous assessment, profiling of the (IDPs) and updating of Evacuation Center Information Board in their respective area of assignment.
- c. Conducted Psychosocial Support Processing (PSP) to the IDPs in Poooc Brgy. Hall Evacuation Center, Balayan, Batangas.

- d. Maintained help desk for Taal victims at the Field Office to accommodate concerns and queries regarding the response operations for Taal Volcanic Activity.

#### 6. Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH)

- a. Deployed equipment and personnel to staging areas at Tanauan City Evacuation Center (Sambat) and Batangas Evacuation Center in Brgy. Laurel, San Pascual, Batangas.
- b. Temporarily Suspended all clearing operations on areas within 14-km danger zone and placed other personnel and equipment on standby at affected DPWH DEO grounds.

#### 7. Department of Agriculture (DA)

DA-PCC, DA-BAI, and the provincial veterinarian, rescued 43 cattle, 3 horses, and 4 carabaos, currently in Tanauan City Slaughterhouse with corn silage, feeds, and water available for them.

- a. Personnel from Alfonso MPS assisted in the unloading of relief goods for the evacuees from Laurel and Talisay, Batangas currently staying at Alfonso Central School.
- b. Personnel from Taal MPS conducted continuous implementation of Mandatory Evacuation/Lockdown in the Municipality of Taal, Batangas.

- a. Transported relief goods from NFA Office Batangas to Cuenca Central School and from Batangas City to Cavite respectively.
- b. Assisted in relocating evacuees from Tanauan North Elementary School to Tanauan City Evacuation Center.
