## A. Volcanic Earthquake

The Taal Volcano Network (TVN) plotted a total of **2,361 volcanic earthquakes** as of **10 February 2020, 1:16 AM**.

## A. Affected Population

- A total <u>134,520 families / 504,709 persons</u> (previous report: 133,696 families / 501,908 persons) were affected in the Provinces of Batangas, Quezon, Laguna, and Cavite.
- Of which, a total of <u>6,857 families / 24,153 persons</u> (previous report: <u>6,206 families / 21,732 persons</u>) are taking temporary shelter in <u>135 evacuation centers</u> (previous report: 128 evacuation centers) while <u>56,625 families / 211,045 persons</u> (previous report: 58,785 families / 220,741 persons) are served outside ECs.
