I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

On 12 January 2020, 2:30 PM, DOST-PHIVOLCS raised the alert status of Taal Volcano from **Alert Level 1 (abnormal)** to **Alert Level 2 (increasing unrest)**. This means that there is probable magmatic intrusion that may or may not lead to an eruption. The public was reminded that the Main Crater should be strictly off-limits because sudden steam explosions can occur and high concentrations of lethal volcanic gases can be released.

At 4:00 PM, the alert status of Taal was raised from Alert Level 2 (increasing unrest) to Alert Level 3 (magmatic unrest). This means that there is magmatic intrusion that is likely driving the current activity. The public was reminded that the entire Volcano Island is a Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ), and entry into the island as well as high-risk barangays of Agoncillo and Laurel is prohibited.

At 5:30 PM, eruptive activity at Taal Volcano Main Crater intensified as continuous eruption generated a tall 10-15 kilometer steam-laden tephra column with frequent volcanic lightning that rained wet ashfall on the general north as far as Quezon City. Volcanic tremor was recorded continuously since 11:00 AM and two volcanic earthquakes of magnitudes M2.5 and M3.9 were felt at Intensity III in Tagaytay City and Alitagtag, Batangas were recorded at 6:15 and 6:22 PM, respectively.

As of 12 January 2020, 7:30 PM, the alert level of Taal Volcano was raised from Alert Level 3 (magmatic unrest) to Alert Level 4 (hazardous eruption imminent). This means that hazardous explosive eruption is possible within hours to days. DOST-PHIVOLCS strongly reiterates total evacuation of Taal Volcano Island and additional evacuation of areas at high risk to pyroclastic density currents and volcanic tsunami within a 14-kilometer radius from Taal Main Crater. Areas in the general north of Taal Volcano were advised to guard against the effects of heavy and prolonged ashfall. Civil aviation authorities must advise aircraft to avoid the airspace around Taal Volcano as airborne ash and ballistic fragments from the eruption column pose hazards to aircraft. DOST-PHIVOLCS is continually monitoring the eruption and will update all stakeholders of further developments.

A. National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC)

1. NDRRM Operations Center (NDRRMOC)

- a. Activated the alert status to RED effective 12 January 2020, 9:00 PM.
- Continuously coordinating with OCDROs III, CALABARZON, and NCR re status of Taal Volcano.
- c. Disseminated information/notification thru Short Messaging System.

2. Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS)

- a. Issued Taal Volcano Bulletin and Eruption Notification.
- b. Continuous monitoring of the situation.

3. Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP)

- a. Duty personnel of the Directorate for Operations is continuously monitoring the incident status in the affected areas.
- b. Coordinated with concerned/affected Regional Offices.
- c. Directed all operating units of affected regions to monitor all port facilities.

4. Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP)

- a. Directed Philippine Air Force (PAF) to provide appropriate aircraft for areal inspection.
- b. Placed respective DRTGs/ DRTUs on alert status effective 12 January 2020 ready to be deployed through the issuance of an order.
- c. Coordinated with the Regional and Local DRRMCs for Disaster Response Readiness and with the LGUs for assistance in the evacuation of residents.

SOLCOM

- a. Deployed SRR Teams for HADR operations.
- b. Coordinated with Regional and Local DRRMCs for Disaster Response.
- c. Prepositioned 5 trucks from 4FSSU, and deployed 5 Tonner Trucks and 1 KM450 truck with 28 enlisted personnel from H4FSSU, Lucena City to Talisay, Batangas to provide manpower and transport assistance thereat.

- c. On 12 January 2020, 4:45 PM, CGS Batangas dispatched additional eight (8) personnel at CGSS Talisay and CGSS San Nicolas to render necessary assistance for the evacuees.
- d. On 12 January 2020, 4:50 PM, Headquarters, Coast Guard District Southern Tagalog (HCGDSTL) deployed a total of 27 personnel and 4 assets to Talisay and 20 personnel and 2 assets in San Nicholas.
- e. On 12 January 2020, 6:30 PM, HCGDSTL deployed 1 team (10 personnel) to augment in San Nicholas, Batangas.
